

What do letter grades mean?

A

The student is doing very good or excellent work; he/she demonstrates an ability to converse and apply the concepts of the subject and a willingness to put in the effort to become proficient in this subject.

B

The student is doing a good job in this subject; he/she demonstrates an understanding of the major concepts and their work reflects an ability to apply these concepts and rules in a reasonable manner. With more time and effort the student might expect to do better.

C

The student exhibits satisfactory work on the major concepts, but does not seem to have a good grasp of the details and/or subtleties of the content or skills. With more time and effort, the student might expect to perform at a B level.

D

The student is barely able to apply the concepts and knowledge in the subject. The assignments and exercises are being completed, but do not show much ability.

F

The student is not performing well in the subject area. His/Her assignments are weak or missing and show no effort or understanding concerning the content area.
